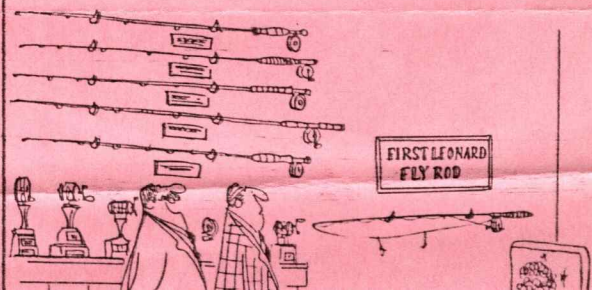
New Member Barbeque
