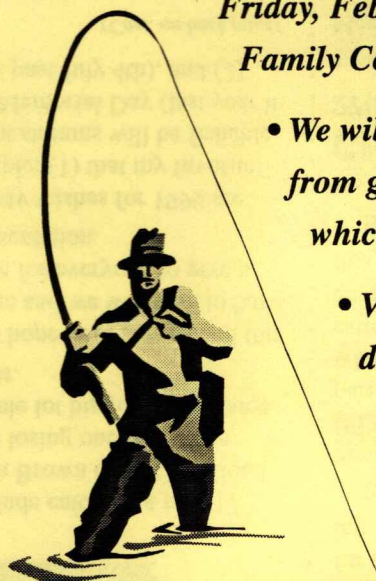

The 27th Annual Dinner / Fund-Raiser will be held Friday, February 26th, 6:00 PM, at the Masonic Family Center on East Avenue.

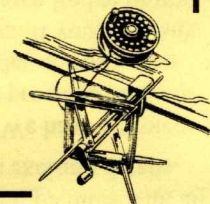
